

Dave - Mandolin

 Brings a clip-onBartlett condenser mic aand a LR Baggs DI

 Needs mic/short stand for the laptop snare and cymbal

Alice - Fiddle, Viola

Brings two clip-on mics
Likes to have a spare mic
stand to hang her fiddle



We like to start with a single monitor mix

Robert - Guitar, Banjo

- Brings a clip-on Bartlett condenser mic and a LR Baggs DI
- May need another mic if he has the banjo with him

Claire - Percussion, Concertina

- Needs mic/stand for bodhrán
- Brings concertina mic and DI
- Needs vocal mic/stand brings microphone mute
- Needs mic for the clogging/foot percussion (board is in front of her chair

Sound mix notes:

Fiddle (Alice) and mandolin (Dave) need to be evenly balanced, so that they can alternate playing lead. Guitar: Robert wants more microphone in the mix than pickup (the pick-up only boosts his signal when he plays lead) Bodhrán: To get a strong bass sound, while also hearing the high tones, try cutting the low frequencies, boosting mids (~600 Hz) and highs, to get as much separation from the guitar's low end as possible.
